

Prayers for Your Husband based on Ephesians 2

As for you, you were dead in your transgressions and sins, in which you used to live when you followed the ways of this world and of the ruler of the kingdom of the air, the spirit who is now at work in those who are disobedient. But because of his great love for us, God, who is rich in mercy, made us alive with Christ even when we were dead in transgressions—it is by grace you have been saved. Ephesians 2:1-2, 4-5 (NIV)

But now in Christ Jesus you who once were far away have been brought near by the blood of Christ. Ephesians 2: 10, 12-13 (NIV)

Dear Lord, I thank You for giving my husband talents and personality traits uniquely planned by You before he was even born. Give him a fresh vision as to how to develop those God-given gifts. Show him how to use them to display who You are to a world in dire need of Your love and truth. Help him to be forever grateful for the life-changing meaning of the cross and for the closeness all believers can share with You. In Jesus' name, Amen.
